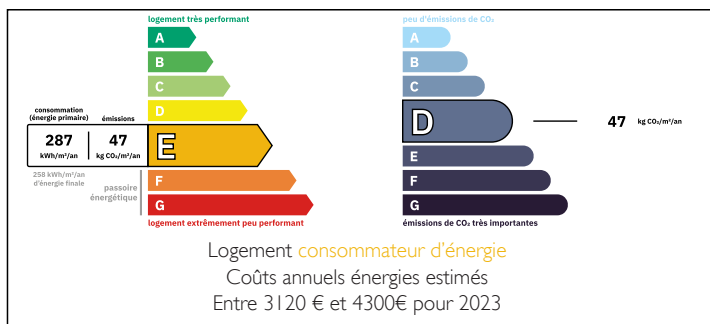

DESCRIPTION

This lovely, longere boasts many period features including exposed beams, stone walls, stone fireplaces and tiled floors. It has a separate 2 bedroom guest house which comfortably sleeps 4. The property also has a large pool, verandah and pretty gardens. situated in a small hamlet, surrounded by apple orchards. The house is currently inhabited all year round. It has a 2nd small cottage which has been used as a gite in the past, although the current owners just use it for family visits. It could easily be an income generator if marketed properly.

The main house has a large open plan living and dining room with a large fitted kitchen. A separate hallway leads to the stairs to the first floor and then into the large formal sitting room. There is a summer room adjoining the sitting room with access to a private part of the gardens. There are 3 good sized bedrooms and a bathroom on the first floor. The well maintained gardens surround the house providing a private, tranquil setting.
