

### DESCRIPTION

There is a fun installation of lights, above the indoor swimming pool, which create an illusion of a cosmic illumination.

The pool is equipped with "searchlights" which illuminate the water with prismatic changes of colour.

A separate Pigeonnier offers lounge, kitchen bedroom bathroom, so has income potential or an excellent office space..
