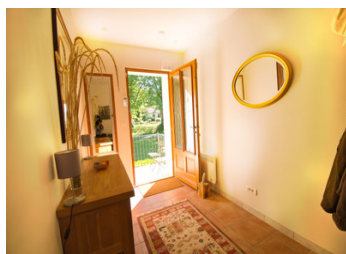

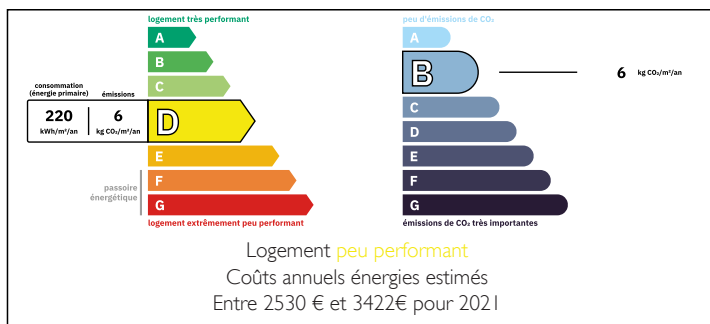

DESCRIPTION

This wonderful five/six bedroom, four bathroom house has amazing views all around. It is just 400 metres from the centre of a beautiful and unspoilt village. Although the house is situated within walking distance from the village, it is far enough away to allow for the peace that the local wildlife adores. There is a wide range of wildlife that frequents the immediate area around the property, including deer, red squirrels, coypu as well as numerous birds such as woodpeckers, black kites, buzzards, kestrels, jays, kingfishers, hoopoe and amazingly bright yellow golden orioles. The property boasts approximately 240 metres of river frontage with a 130m² decking area that runs the entire rear of the property at the upper floor level. This area is perfect for relaxing, sunbathing, entertaining and provides you and your guests with spectacular views across the river. There is an island just offshore that provides a home for numerous species of egret, grey and purple herons, cormorants, gulls, sandpipers and many other birds. The view is constantly changing with variations in light and the different seasons. The Garonne River is directly on the migration route of many birds including osprey which are often seen as they migrate south in July and August. In front of the house, just 40 metres away, is the Entre Deux Mers canal. The canal lock and the wharf the other side are close enough to enable you to moor your boat, and be able to walk...
