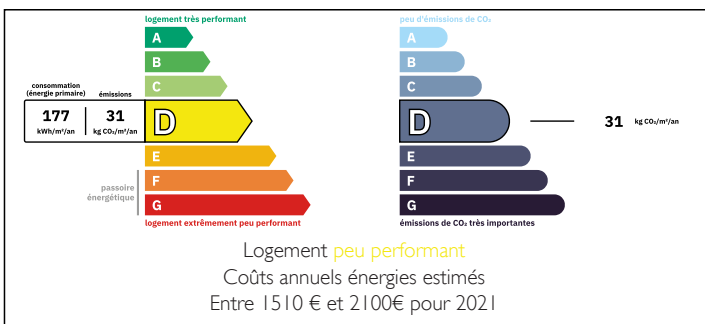

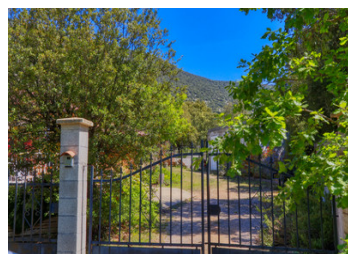
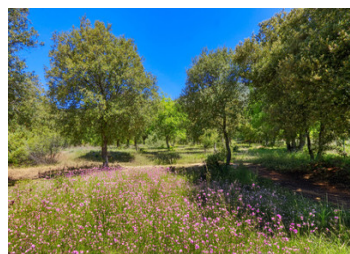

The bakery is known for its excellent bread. The local grocery store offers a fine selection of cheeses and outstanding charcuterie. The village's terraces, brasseries, and restaurants under the shade of majestic plane trees create a warm and welcoming atmosphere. In summer, the weekly market brings the village to life, along with various events such as antique fairs and concerts.

You'll also find a post office, a nursery and primary school, a town hall, a bistro, an inn, a pizzeria, as well as potters and a few art galleries. Surrounded by nature, the village is set amid lavender fields, endless forests, and striking ochre cliffs. The nearby mountains offer breathtaking scenery with ever-changing colors.

The town of Apt, just 10 km away, offers a full range of shops, a high school, a middle school, a cinema, and restaurants. Every Saturday morning, its famous Provençal market fills the streets with vibrant colors and local flavors. Avignon's TGV station is about 1 hour 15 minutes by car, and Marseille airport is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes away.
