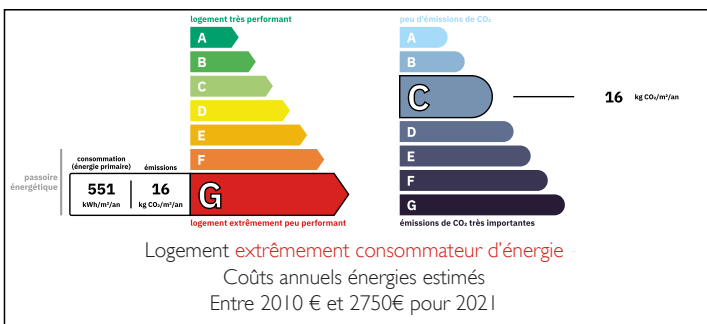

DESCRIPTION

Set in the heart of Ségur-le-Château, this three-bedroom property offers a rare opportunity to combine history, charm, and modern living potential. The house retains many original features, including wood flooring, exposed beams, fireplaces in every bedroom, and a beautiful vaulted cellar.

The ground floor features an entrance hallway leading to a welcoming 20 m² living room with wood-burning stove, and a spacious open-plan kitchen/dining room of 25 m² – ideal for family gatherings. A separate WC completes this level.

Upstairs, you'll find three bright bedrooms (11 m², 17 m², 21 m²), each with its own fireplace, plus a shower room with wash basin. The attic offers scope for additional living space if desired.

Beneath the house, a basement provides workshop space and a stunning vaulted cellar, while a street-level garage ensures easy parking.

Outside, the 394 m² plot includes a generous rear garden with countryside views – perfect for summer dining and relaxation.

Ségur-le-Château is a vibrant village with a rich history, best known for its medieval château under restoration. During the summer months, lively night markets bring locals and visitors together in the main square to enjoy local produce, food, and live music. Everyday amenities are close at hand, with Lubersac and Amac-Pompadour just 10 minutes away by car.

This property is ideal for anyone seeking a renovation project in a charming setting with strong tourist appeal.
