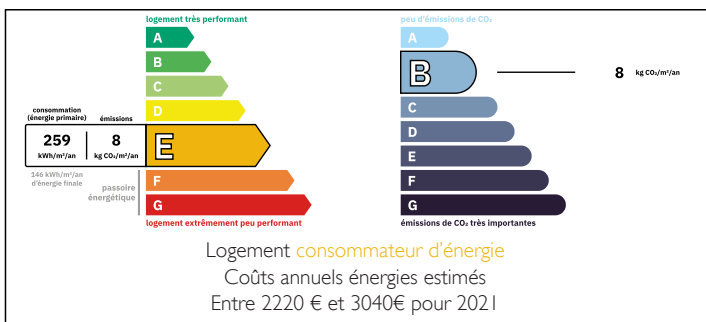

DESCRIPTION

In the heart of the Southwest region,
Close to Bergerac Airport (68 km),
Bordeaux Airport (167 km),
and Toulouse Airport (119.6 km);
near the towns of Fumel, Villeneuve-sur-Lot, and
Agen—the latter offering a flight connection to Paris
of just 1 hour and 25 minutes.

By TGV train, Toulouse and Bordeaux are one hour
away,

and Paris is four hours away.

The area features gently rolling hills and a mosaic
of meadows, woodlands, and cultivated landscapes.
It boasts exceptional architectural heritage,
including fortified medieval towns,
hilltop villages, châteaux, abbeys, and mills. It is close
to two towns—

one of which was a major fortified town
and is now home to artists and artisans—
where one can enjoy strolling along cobbled streets
lined with beautiful facades,
stopping for a bite to eat at restaurants
serving local produce, or simply taking in the view.
The Lot River, flowing below, is navigable,
offering a unique way to explore the region.

This elegantly proportioned château, in need of
renovation, awaits a new owner to make it their
own. A long hallway leads to the château's various
reception rooms. Flanking the hallway are two spiral
staircases, each leading to the upper floors which
comprises: an entrance hall, kitchen, library, living
room, sitting room with fireplace, 6 bedrooms, and
3 bathrooms. Each tower—featuring a spacious
bedroom and bathroom—

could easily be converted into a guest suite. There
are also cellars, outbuildings, and two separate
dwellings. The first property features, on the ground
floor, a spacious fitted kitchen, a living room with
access to a private terrace, a pellet stove, and...
