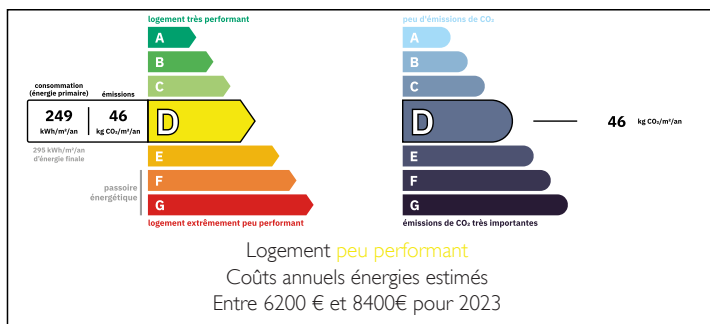
Enjoy alfresco dining at its finest!
