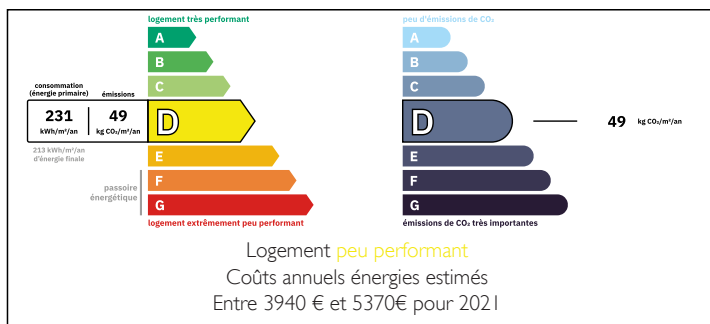
IN BRIEF

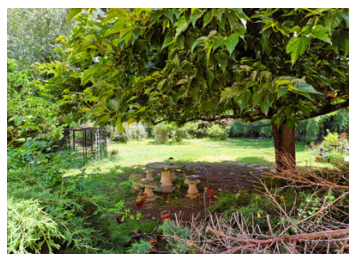
