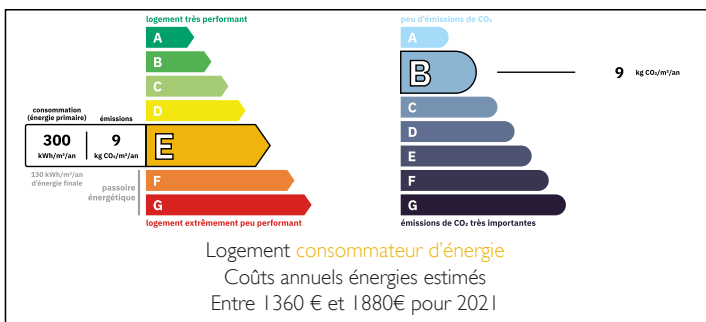
This stylish apartment is set in a quiet road close to the centre of a thriving Gascon village with all shops and services.

DESCRIPTION

At the front of the property there is a covered porch area (7m²) with stone floor and attractive original stone details.

From the main entrance you enter into the open plan kitchen (17.5m²) with a window out to the front porch.

At the back of the kitchen, a door leads to the stairway to the first floor. There are storage and utility areas around the stairwell

On the first floor there is an open landing area with lots of light, and two bedrooms situated to the front of the property (15m² and 10m²). There is a bathroom with double sink and glass tiled shower (5m²) and a separate WC (2m²).

From the landing, wooden stairs lead up to the 2nd floor attic room. This room is currently used as a bedroom (28m²) but could have a variety of uses. The central part of this room is 2m high with the ceiling sloping down towards the front and the back. This property has been sympathetically restored and throughout you will find attractive feature windows and open wooden beams.
