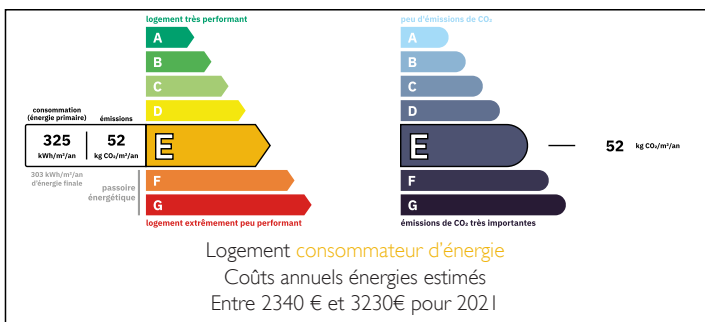

DESCRIPTION

From the delightful courtyard you enter the house via the centrally located kitchen where you will find a large, modern, kitchen island with integrated cooker, overhead extraction, fitted sink and breakfast counter, and plenty of space for free standing storage. There is access to the cellar and a stable door to the rear with a further door to the dining room. With tiled floor, open staircase to the first floor and set of double doors to the front, this is a delightful room for family meals and entertaining. Off the dining room is a light and spacious lounge with beautiful stone fireplace and inset wood burner, leading through to a luminous and tranquil study space that benefits for a mezzanine and double height ceiling and windows.

At the other end of the ground floor, the kitchen also leads off to a utility area and a hallway with downstairs WC and a characterful, cosy, double bedroom with pretty tiled floor and rustic exposed beams. There is an entrance from this end of the house into the smaller barn which has a first floor, lovely old fireplace and an entrance onto the front garden.

Upstairs there are 2 light and comfortable double bedrooms and a bathroom with wc, hand basin, and shower over the half bath.

The house benefits from UPVC double glazing, oil-fired central heating, a septic tank installed in 2017, and a refreshed roof.
