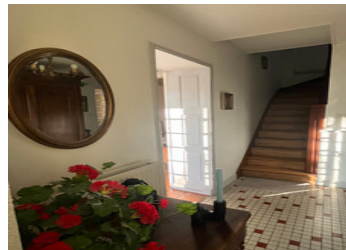

IN BRIEF

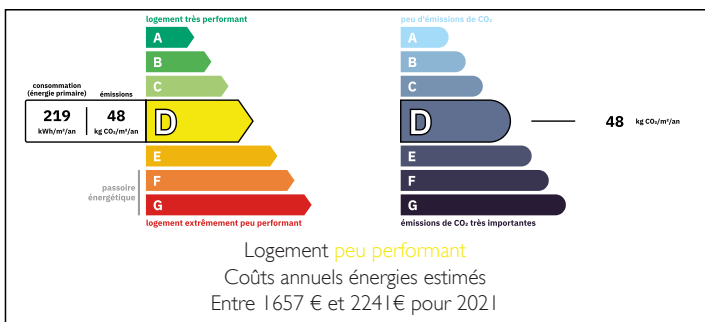
Nestled in the heart of a small village bordered by the Dordogne river, this house is close to shops. The town of Bergerac and its international airport are about twenty kilometres away.
