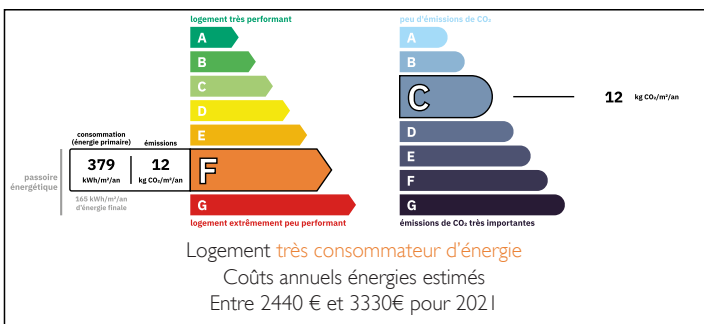

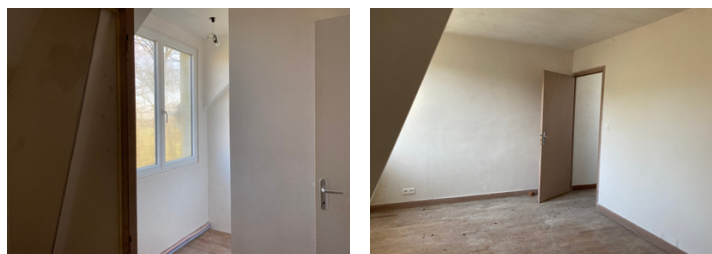

DESCRIPTION

The front door opens onto a small entrance hall, to the right of which is a large and airy room (30m²) that would make a lovely living room, having a large fireplace in the centre. To the rear another sizeable room (23m²) that has the capacity to be transformed into a cozy country kitchen.

Returning to the front room, a wooden staircase takes you to the first floor, where there are three good-sized bedrooms (10m², 14m² and 15m²) and a potential bathroom.
