Rare opportunity to purchase an historic stone property in a sought after village location. The property is currently divided into two separate apartments with entrances on different streets. It is generally in good condition, well insulated with double glazing throughout. The house is believed to date back to the 17th century and was previously the village grainery. Over a total surface area of 105m², the property as a whole contains 2 shower rooms, 3 bedrooms, and two kitchens with basic facilities. Both apartments were rented out until very recently and could easily be rented out again with a small investment. The property could easily be returned to a 3 bedroom townhouse as the staircase is still there. In close proximity to some great restaurants in the lovely village of Lauzerte, this will be a great investment for someone.

REGION

In the northwest corner of the Tarn et Garonne department, Lauzerte lies between the foothills of the Massif Central and the Garonne river plain in the region known as Quercy Blanc and Pays de Serres because of the limestone which predominates in the landscape. The hill town rises above parallel valleys and rivers, the Barguelonnes, the Lendou and the Seoune which feed into the Garonne River.

Lauzerte is surrounded by agricultural land known for Melons de Quercy, Chasselas de Moissac (white dessert grapes), and Pruneaux d'Agen (prunes).
