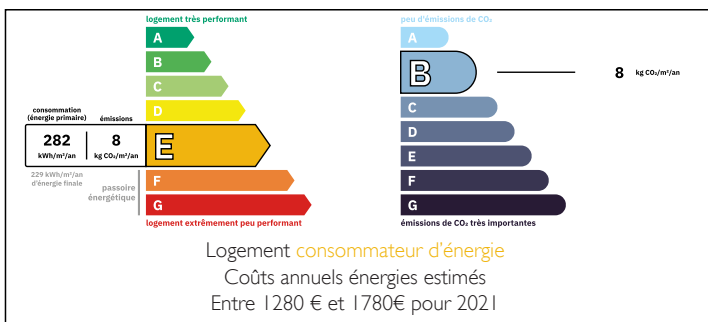

DESCRIPTION

From the road, through the gate to enter the secluded garden where we find the front door. Entrance hall with space for coats and shoes, electricity fuse board in cupboard.

Through to large, open-plan living space. Very usable kitchen arranged in one corner, Gas hob, electric oven, large island, black slate work surface.

Wood-burning stove with ventilated system of ducting taking heat to the upstairs rooms. This system heats the entire house and keeps it at a cosy temperature throughout the winter.

Plenty of room for dining table and chairs, lounge seating in front of the fire.

Larder plus storage cupboard under stairs.

Access to garden via large sliding glass doors giving onto concrete patio area, further to lawn, shed at far end. The garden is granted privacy by a large hedge on the road side and a high wall on the boundary with the neighbours' garden. Mature climbing plants provide interest and shade.

From the living area, wooden stairs up to 1st floor. Here we find:

One large double bedroom with walk-in wardrobe, views to garden

One double bedroom with view to quiet street

One bedroom with view to quiet street through cute little square window

At the end of the corridor, space for washing machine

Large, modern bathroom with double wash basins, WC, generous bath and spacious glazed shower, tiled floor, view to garden

From the corridor, door opens to stairs up to attic rooms:

Large landing area with potential as playroom, bedroom, office, library...

One large and interesting space with "Velux"-type roof lights, exposed...
