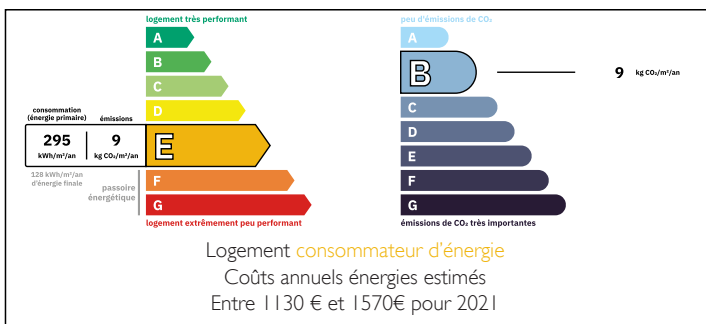

Located midway between the shops and restaurants of the town square, and the stone-arched bridge over the rushing river Brame, this beautifully restored and renovated house is all ready for you to move into and enjoy.

The meticulously restored façade features louvered steel shutters and the brick-and-tile cornice typical of southern France. The clay tile roof and the solid zinc gutters and downspouts are brand new. The walls have just been coated with a durable, ochre-tinted, water repelling finish that offers long lasting protection for the 70 centimetre thick stone walls.

The solid mahogany door with its steel security grille and inlaid brass decoration gives step-free access to the entry with its tough, antique tile floor, exquisitely laid to resemble an oriental carpet. But not a rectangular one : already in the entry, this house begins to reveal its characterful, quirkily shaped rooms.

Hang your coat, put away your hat, and change into your slippers in the street-level entry thanks to the ingeniously designed hooks and shelves that provide generous storage and eliminate clutter without seeming to take up any space at all.
