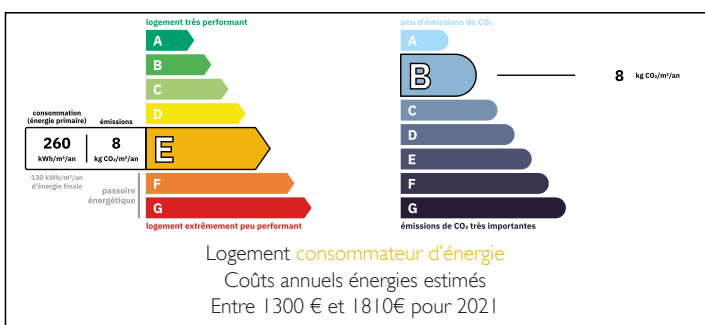
IN BRIEF

A charming old stone cottage house that has been thoughtfully renovated to create a cosy, very comfortable home that is ready to move into.

Situated in a quiet hamlet in the commune of Ecuras, this lovely property offers an open plan living space on the ground floor and two bedrooms and a bathroom on the first floor.

Full amenities can be found in the nearby lively market town of Montbron (9km) while the city of Angouleme is 45km away. An 18 hole international golf course is less than 5km away and the popular leisure lakes of the Haute Charente and Saint Estephe are nearby.

DESCRIPTION

A lovely old stone house that has been thoughtfully renovated to create a lovely mix of the old (wooden floorboards and oak beams) and the new (double glazing, insulation and skylights).

The ground floor has been transformed into a large open plan space (47m²) with a fully equipped kitchen at one end, a pellet burner against the back wall and a lounge at the other end.

The middle space lends itself perfectly as a dining room with views over the front and rear of the property. Large windows let in plenty of natural light and wooden floorboards add warmth. A modest cellar under the house is accessed from the rear garden - perfect for that wine collection.

The first floor has a landing (5m²) which leads to two bedrooms (15m² & 12m²). Windows give both rooms a bright feel and the master also has skylights. The bathroom (3m²) is shared between the two bedrooms and has a walk-in shower, bath, washbasin and WC - the space has certainly been used well.

Outside, there is a small front garden with a raised seating area and wooden decking and a larger garden behind the house. The large terrace is what remains of a large barn and has been renovated to provide a covered seating area with views over the surrounding countryside. At one end, there is a lovely old bread oven that can still be used and a space that could easily...
