Spacious, light-filled commercial premises on the ground floor.

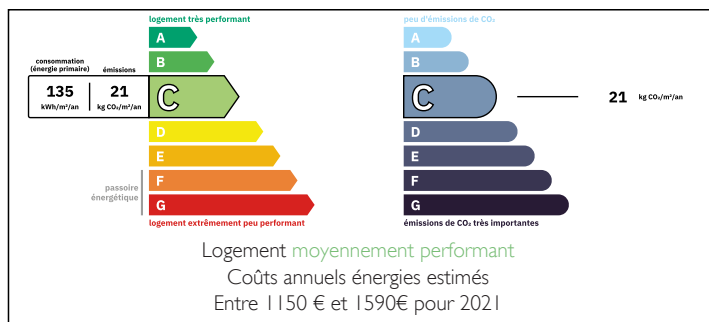
Large, high cellar and boiler room.

DESCRIPTION

Restored bourgeois house in the heart of Bourdeilles, in the Dordogne. Some of the original architectural features have been preserved, including the magnificent and rare 16th century wooden spiral staircase set in a inside tower (in perfect condition) which leads to the 2 upper floors.

House with 160m² of living space and 2 en suite bedrooms,

A 43m² flat on the top floor awaiting conversion.

Commercial premises of 37m² with exposed stone walls and a cellar of 47m² with a recent oil-fired boiler.

The house has no garden, but is a short distance from green spaces.

1st floor

A 33 m² living room with fireplace and double aspect, a 26.5 m² fitted kitchen with fireplace, a 14.5 m² bedroom with fireplace, a shower room with heated towel rail and a separate WC.

Most of the wooden joinery is double-glazed, there are wooden parquet floors throughout and the walls are insulated.

2nd floor

A large double aspect bedroom of 34m² with "plafonds à la française" wood parquet flooring and a magnificent fireplace, shower room with separate WC. The 2 wooden windows are single-glazed. The walls are insulated.

1/2 floor above

A flat of 43m² needs to be finished. It is located under the eaves and is 3.3 m high.

The under-roof insulation is in place, the windows are double-glazed and the electric and water supply ducts are in place.
