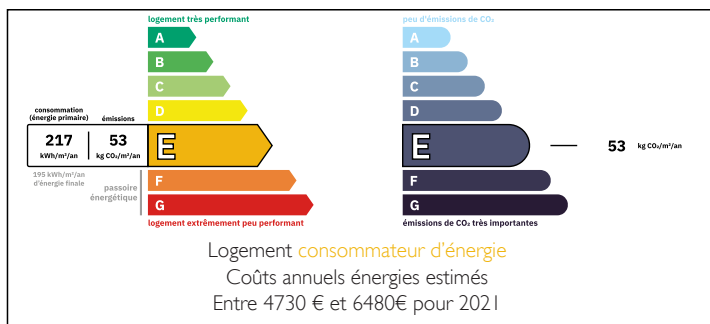

DESCRIPTION

You enter the property via a courtyard into an entrance hall. To the left, there is a cozy lounge featuring a log-burning stove and access to the rear garden. This space leads into a large kitchen with a dining area at one end, and a pantry/utility room at the other. Double doors from the kitchen open to the front of the property. The oil-fueled central heating boiler is located in the utility room, with the fuel tank housed in a small outbuilding adjacent to the house.

On the opposite side of the house, you'll find a formal dining room followed by a spacious living room with an additional dining area. The lounge area is heated by a fuel-burning stove. At this end of the house there are two bedrooms that share a Jack and Jill bathroom. Below this section, there is a large study. Currently, the property is used as a large holiday home, with an apartment reserved for a housekeeper. However the main house could easily be divided into two or three separate accommodations if desired.

The first floor features two more bedrooms and a bathroom. On the top floor, there is a bedroom built into the eaves, complete with an ensuite shower room. Additionally, a separate one-bedroom apartment is accessible via a staircase from the courtyard.

Outside, the property offers a swimming pool, two stables, a potting shed, two barns, a wood store, and ample off-road parking. The property also includes a cellar and...
