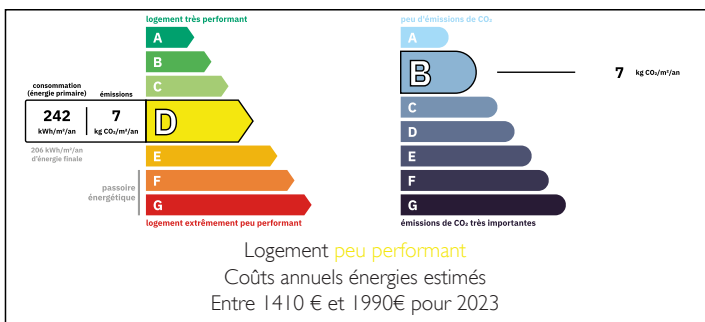

From the pretty front garden, you immediately enter the bright and airy entrance hall (approx 16 m²) with tiled floor and electric radiator. To the rear there is the WC (approx 2 m²) , with a basin and space for the washing machine. There is also a door leading to the back garden.

To the right of the entrance hall, you enter the dining room (approx 16 m²) with the original tomettes on the floor, a lovely fireplace and beautiful exposed beams. This room has a double glazed window to the front of the property and a door to the side.

Access to the well equipped fitted kitchen (approx 15 m²). you will also find a Rayburn stove that is plumbed to heat some of the radiators and is ideal for keeping the kitchen cosy and warm in the winter. With tiles on the floor, a door leading out to the terrace and the stunning back garden and a window to the side of the property. This is a perfect county cottage kitchen.

Back into the entrance hall and the double doors lead to the spacious and welcoming living room (approx 23 m²) The tiled floor follows on from the hall. There is a woodburning stove for cosy winter nights, a small window to the front and lovely double doors leading out to the terrace and the garden.
