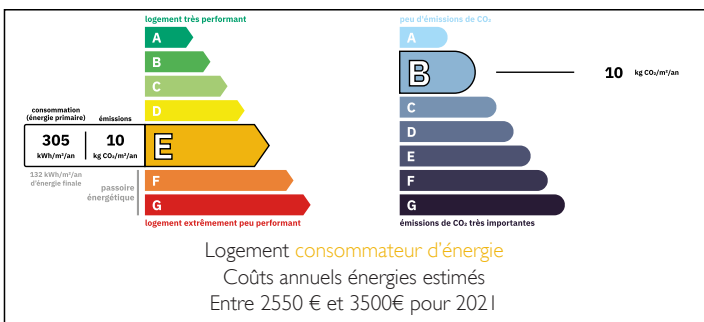

DESCRIPTION

In the vibrant Minervois village of Azille, with shops, cafés, and a weekly market just steps away, this exceptional stone home offers the perfect base to enjoy southern France. The UNESCO-listed city of Carcassonne is only 30 minutes away, and the Mediterranean beaches or Pyrenees are within an hour.

Ground Floor – A welcoming entrance hall leads to a generous open-plan living/dining/kitchen anchored by a striking stone fireplace and ducted heating. A large walk-in pantry, cellar, and guest WC add practicality, while an elegant Art Deco staircase conceals a smart utility area (fridge/freezer, washer, dryer, water softener).

First Floor – Three spacious double bedrooms, each with a private ensuite. Two enjoy balcony access with sun-filled views over the village square.

Second Floor – A full-height attic, already plumbed, awaits transformation into a master suite, studio, or entertainment space.

Outdoor Living – The showpiece roof terrace, framed by oak beams and traditional tiles, is perfect for summer dining and relaxation, with sliding doors, planters, and discreet bird-proofing.

Garages & Workshop – Internal access to a vast double garage with one manual and one electric roller door, plus direct rear-lane entry. Space for up to five vehicles or a boat, alongside a bright, high-ceilinged workshop.

Garden Potential – A private light well offers an ideal spot for a fernery or vertical garden.
