DESCRIPTION

The main entrance is accessible via the south-facing private courtyard with a very spacious garage (former stable) of 80 m², accommodating at least 3 cars.

The ground floor offers:

- Entrance

- Living room with a fireplace and entrance to the garden with fully grown trees, a small fountain, and an old pigeon house with a small atelier
- 1st bedroom with bathroom (bath)

Additionally, the property includes a 60 m² independent guest house with a kitchen, which could be rented out with regular income.

The castle is surrounded by 20 hectares of land in co-ownership with five other owners and includes an olive grove, a furnished outbuilding (former guardian's house), and an outdoor relaxation area with a 25 m x 6 m swimming pool.
