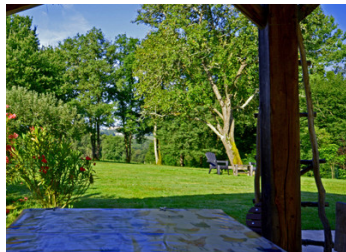

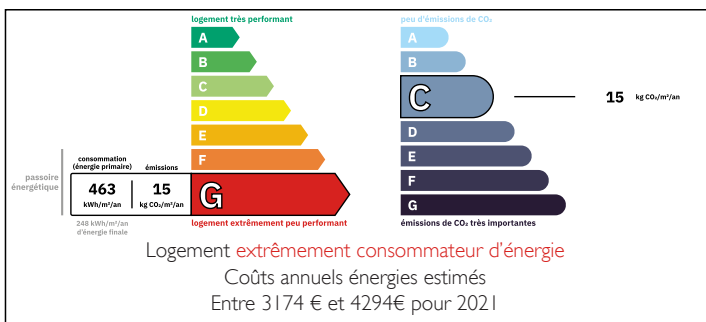

A very pretty 5 bedroom stone farmhouse which was already in situ when marked on the cadastre Napoléon map of 1811. In a pretty position with spectacular views through the trees across the valley towards Hautefort castle in the distance, this property has a large open plan sitting/dining room/kitchen with doors that open onto the garden and the pool. There are 3 bedrooms (2 adjoining) on the ground floor and 2 bedrooms upstairs. In short, a perfect home or escape in the country for a family of all ages ready to move into.

DESCRIPTION

A classic mid to late 18th century "Fermette Périgordine" in stone in its own at the edge of a tiny hamlet of only 2 other properties of similar antiquity and at a reasonable distance (behind) :-

Ground floor

Sitting room/Dining room/Kitchen with tiled floor, large traditional stone fireplace with wood burner, original oak ceiling beams, windows and French doors opening onto the garden each side 28 m²

Rear hall/utility room with French door onto the garden 4 m²

1st bedroom with French door access to the courtyard 16 m²

Washroom, tiled throughout with shower, washbasin and w/c 4 m²

W/c with washbasin 2 m²

2nd bedroom with window and French door access to garden 10 m²

3rd bedroom (accessed from 1st bedroom) with window facing the courtyard 10 m²

1st floor

4th bedroom (directly up the stairs from the ground floor washroom), with a gable end French door and safety barrier railing overlooking woodland 10 m²

Up further steps to 5th bedroom with exposed roof beams, dormer window overlooking the courtyard, velux window facing garden and view, ensuite washroom with washbasin and w/c 16 m² and 1,5 m² respectively

Loft area accessed by separate staircase which is neat, cleared, refloored, insulated with 2 velux and 1 dormer windows, side walling currently underway 12,5 m² (standing area)

Further loft space (undeveloped) beyond the chimney stack

Outside

1 hectare of garden with lawn and two meadows and woodland with distant views towards Hautefort Castle
