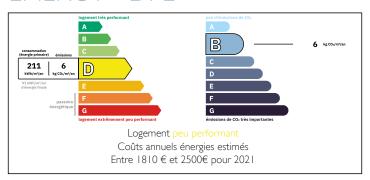

## DESCRIPTION

This property is down a quiet lane with no through traffic, in a small hamlet. There is a large front garden with plenty of space to park. Open the front door and enter the property into a large hallway with a tiled floor. To the left is the door to the large dining room and kitchen. The kitchen is modern with fitted appliances. There is a large dining table area plus a cosy snug area. There are patio doors that open into the front garden. On the ground floor there is also a large shower room with sink and WC. The living room has a large open fireplace and views over fields.

Another door at the rear of the hallway takes you into the original cow shed. This is currently used for storage but could be developed further into a garage or utility room for example. It currently has a corrugated pressed cement roof and a concrete floor. The staircase leads to the first floor which has three large bedrooms, two of which have ensuite shower rooms plus a family bathroom. The large landing is currently used as an office area and another solid staircase leads to the attic which is boarded and ready to be renovated. The size of the rooms are as follows:
