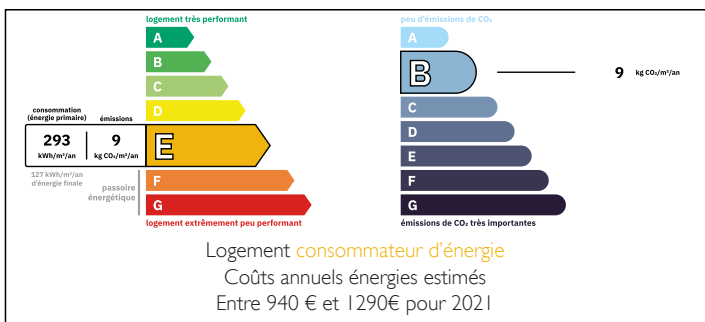

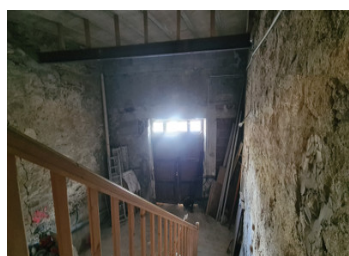

DESCRIPTION

Unique three story bijou property, featuring a spacious terrace, cave, garage and potential for renovation, presenting an ideal opportunity for either a permanent residence or a holiday retreat.

Ground Floor

The entrance to this village house is approached via a charming pathway, set back from the street. Upon entering the front door, one is welcomed into a central living area that includes a cosy snug equipped with a modern wood burner. A doorway from the snug leads to a generous size open-plan kitchen and dining area, where glass folding doors open onto a large terrace, offering breath taking views of the surrounding mountains and vineyards.

Returning to the central living area, there is access to both the upper and lower levels.

First Floor:

From the snug, stairs ascend to a double bedroom complete with ensuite shower and WC.

Lower Ground on Two Levels:

Returning to the centre room, and near the front entrance, stairs descend to a spacious cave area that includes a second separate WC and shower room. This space offers various possibilities for conversion, perhaps as an occasional sleeping area or a serene cool space. Currently it is used for storage. The cave connects to a spacious garage, via a wooden staircase, with large double doors that open onto the street below.
