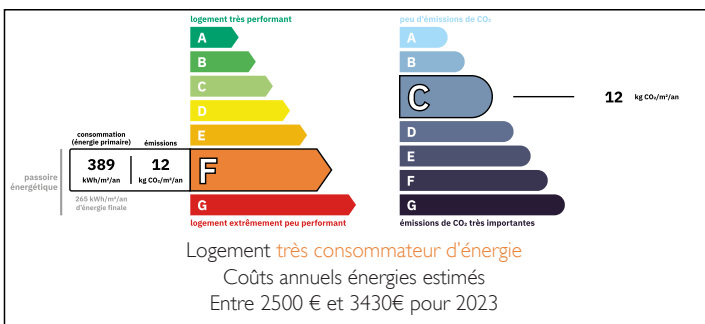

DESCRIPTION

In a beautiful countryside location which benefits from a micro-climate and with agricultural (non-constructible) land around, the property is less than 5kms from Malestroit, a very popular year-round riverside town with primary schools, middle schools, plenty of sport facilities and other activities, a weekly market and even its own rock and medieval festivals in the summer.

The house was completely renovated in 2010-2011 and while still very presentable, perhaps some heating/insulation upgrading would help to bring it up to today's standards. Before or after though, you still have a gorgeous and practical home in a great location!

The entrance leads into the kitchen / dining room, fully equipped, in which there is a woodburner. To the left is the lounge with another woodburner. From the lounge up the staircase there are two bedrooms each with its own bathroom and toilet. On the ground floor, to the right of the kitchen is an en-suite bedroom and plus an additional separate guest toilet and a large, bright utility room.

The garden is well-established with trees, bushes and flowers, particularly lovely in the summer

A detached stone outbuilding, could be renovated (subject to planning approval) and a second septic tank, pending, has been planned for this purpose. The existing system needs some remedial works (tarpaulin to be removed from the sand filter and a secondary ventilation to be raised 40 cm above the roof).
