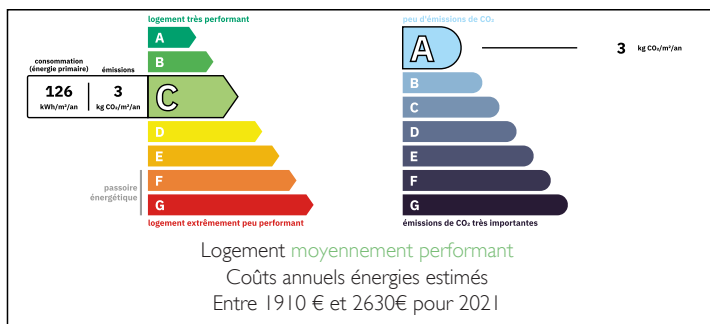

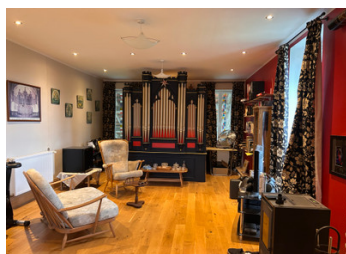
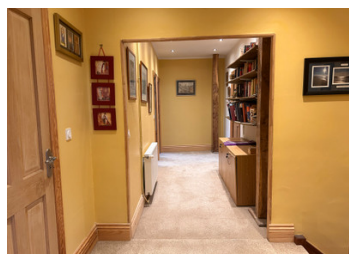

DESCRIPTION

This spacious and beautifully finished stone-built home offers the perfect balance of traditional charm and modern convenience, set against the backdrop of a peaceful lake and wooded landscape.

As you enter the home, a grand hallway leads directly to a large covered rear terrace—the perfect spot to relax while enjoying the open views of the lake, where fishing is permitted (fee-based).

On the ground floor, you'll find:

A bright and welcoming living room (38m²) featuring exposed stone walls and a cozy wood-burning stove

A modern fully fitted kitchen (15m²) with double ovens and hobs, leading into

A spacious dining/living room (41m²)—ideal for entertaining large families or guests

A walk-in shower room with WC, plus a boiler/utility room for extra storage

A classic staircase from the hallway takes you to the first floor, where the space continues to impress:

A carpeted landing leads to a master suite (23m²) with its own luxurious en-suite bathroom (11m²) including a jacuzzi bath, walk-in shower, double sinks, bidet, and enclosed WC, plus a generous dressing room (5m²)

Two additional double bedrooms (each 13m²)

A multi-purpose room (40m²)—currently used as a playroom or music room, but easily dividable into two separate bedrooms

A smaller office or single bedroom (7m²)

A family bathroom with walk-in shower, corner bath, and WC
