Entering under the imposing tower, the peaceful courtyard gives way to the principal house with six bedrooms, 4 bathrooms, kitchen and large living room with mezzanine study.

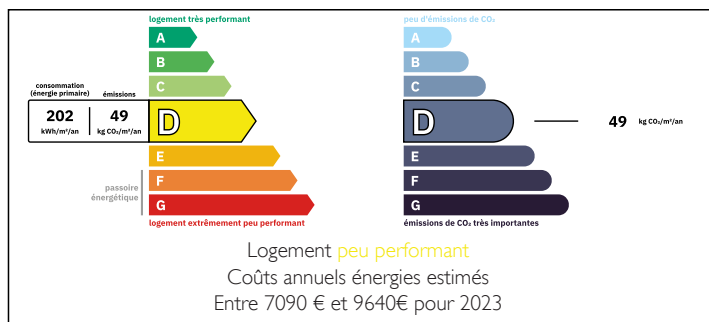
The main house also has two large barns attached which currently offer storage and workshop space but could be converted to accommodation with permissions.

The guest house comprises 8 ensuite double bedrooms (partially completed) with two ground floor communal rooms and two more to be developed upstairs.
