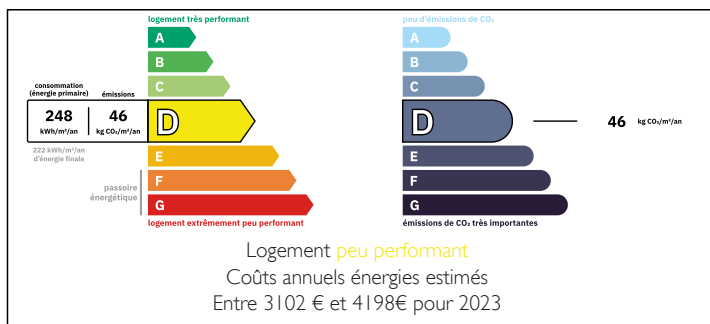

DESCRIPTION

Benefitting from a program of improvements since 2018, the property has had new plumbing and electrics in the house and barn, and a new fosse septique installed in 2019. The barn is light and airy, with plenty of ground-floor and upstairs space. It could be used as a studio/workshop for any number of creative projects, or be developed as a gîte, subject to the usual consents.

Outside, there is a patio spanning the entire length of the house, with individual awnings providing shelter all year long for al fresco dining. There is a car port, a useful log store, and plenty of storage areas in the barn. Fully enclosed, the front garden is pretty and peaceful. To the one side is the field with current planning permission to build a detached house, but other projects could be considered. Alternatively, this field would be a wonderful space for growing your own fruit & veg and keeping hens.

The property is in a friendly hamlet, just outside the village of Feusines. Feusines has a nursery school, salle des fêtes, church dating back to the 12th century, ancient lavoir and Mairie. Shops and services can be found in the historic village of Sainte-Sévère-sur-Indre, just 5kms away, and further amenities are in the lovely small town of La Châtre (15 minutes). This ancient Berry region of central France is renowned for its connections with world-famous novelist George Sand, and is loved by artists, writers, musicians and creatives alike for...
