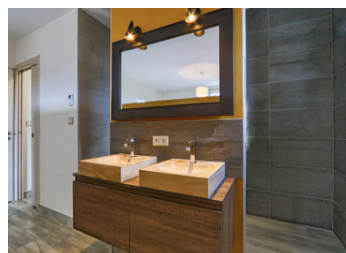

Bright and modern house in Gargas – Ideal as a primary or secondary residence

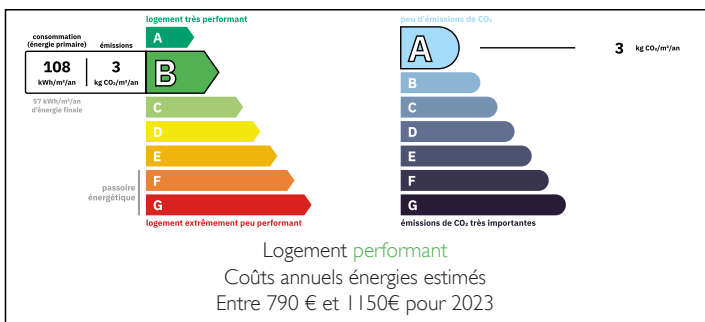

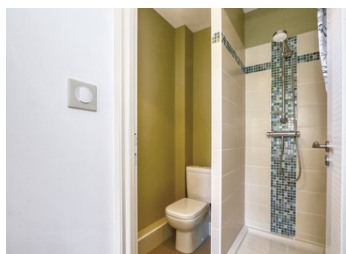

DESCRIPTION

The house was built by the company Mas en Provence, renowned for the exceptional quality of its constructions. For example, the foundations were made with numerous micropiles, ensuring optimal stability of the building.

Gargas, a charming village in the Luberon in Provence, is famous for its small Friday market and its ochre quarries, particularly the Mines de Bruoux, attracting many tourists and cycling or hiking enthusiasts.

The neighborhood offers a pleasant tranquility, with the school and shops just a few minutes' walk away: bakery, supermarket, pharmacy, hairdresser, doctors, restaurants, town hall, post office, etc.

Apt, located just 2 km away, offers middle schools, large retail stores, a cinema, restaurants, and a bus station. The Avignon TGV station is just an hour's drive away, and the Marseille airport is 1 hour and 15 minutes away.

The Luberon, a true gem of Provence, offers an idyllic setting with its picturesque villages, natural diversity, and cultural activities.

There are many activities available, ranging from hikes through the ochre and lavender hills to bike rides to Mont Ventoux through olive groves and vineyards. The Provence markets, such as those in Apt, Lourmarin, Bonnieux, or Isle-sur-la-Sorgue, are full of local products, while artistic festivals and outdoor concerts enliven summer evenings.

Nearby villages such as Gordes, Roussillon, and Bonnieux captivate with their medieval charm, cobbled streets, and panoramic views of the Luberon valley. The region also offers historical sites such as the center of Apt, the Sénanque Abbey, and the Lourmarin Castle.
