A light airy spacious house with wonderful views. Set in the ideal position; a short walk to the local small village bread shop and cafe/bar but no close neighbours.

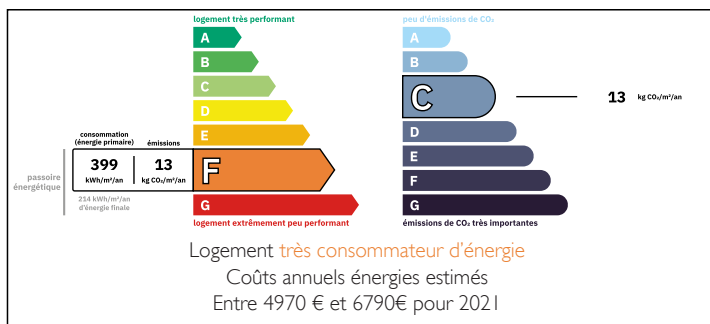
