This is a fantastic opportunity to purchase an amazing country house steeped in history, built around 1640 and retaining many original features such as huge stone fireplaces and oak beams.

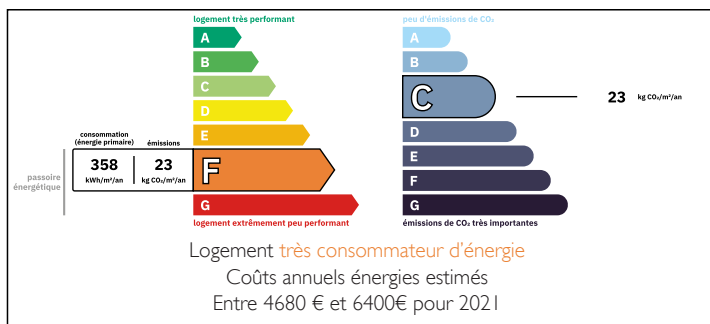
Not only that, but it has solar panels which provide hot water and electricity, and generates a small income.
