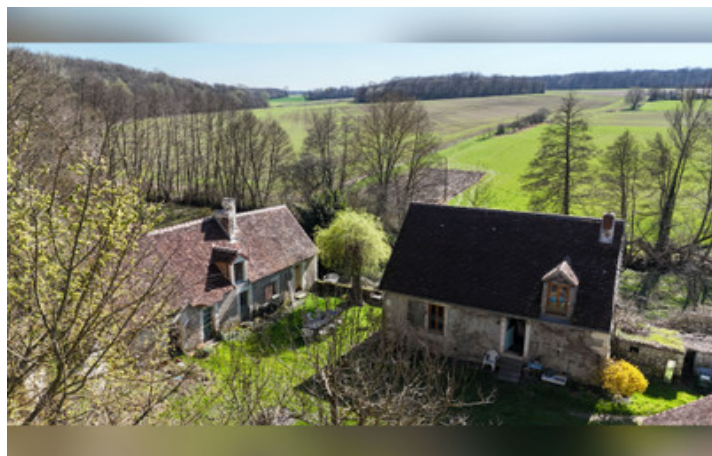


Attractive isolated property with two houses, outbuildings, stream and wonderful countryside views.

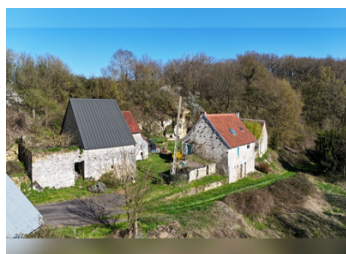

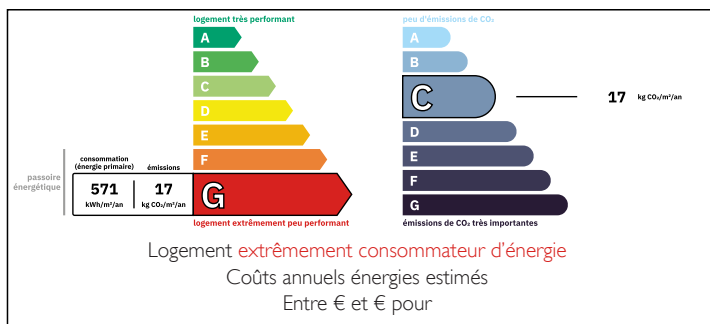

DESCRIPTION

This former farm lies at the end of a quiet country lane. On arrival at the property, there is a three bay parking barn and entry to the courtyard via a metal gate. The buildings are set high above the stream and benefit from wonderful views.

The principal house is located on the right and extends over three floors. The lower floor is accessed from the path in front and is currently used for storage. There are two large rooms (31m² and 27m²) with high ceilings which could be incorporated into the main house with the addition of a staircase

Enter the living area of the main house from the courtyard via a few steps into the dual aspect kitchen/living room (34m²) with large inset woodburner. Beautiful far reaching view from one window over the land, stream and surrounding fields. The other window faces the courtyard and remaining buildings.

A doorway off the kitchen leads to a hallway (6m²) with access to a double bedroom (11.8m²) with a window into the courtyard. Opposite the bedroom is a toilet (2m²) and a separate bathroom (7m²) with bath and shower over, and a large window over the valley. A staircase leads up to the first floor with office/reading area (13.4m²), a single bedroom (9m²) with velux window overlooking stream. There is also an L-shaped bedroom (11m²) with two sleeping areas, joined by a seating area with a large...
