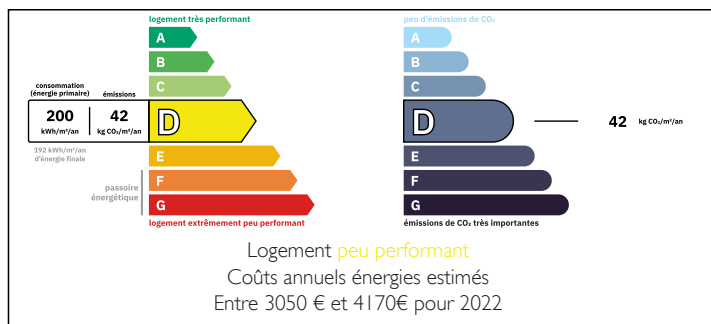

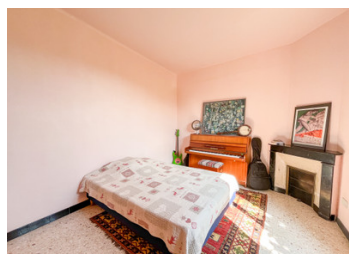

DESCRIPTION

Located on the edge of a historic village you'll find this impressive 'Bourgeoise' house offering bright and spacious living with a charming garden, balcony and far-reaching views.

A small stairway takes you to the garden of this charming property, it offers plenty of space to relax, a well offers water for the garden, there is a covered area that would make an ideal summer kitchen and there is the option to add a pool of around 6x3sqm. A variety of plants adorn the garden with its old lemon tree producing around 300kg of fruit yearly. The garden offers fantastic views with its south facing orientation. Access to the garage is also provided from the garden.

Up to the house with its historic door opens into the hall with its charming tiles and wooden features. To the left you find a semi open plan fitted kitchen, this leads to a spacious and bright lounge with superb views and access to the balcony, off the lounge a bedroom with separate closet area. From the hall this leads you to another bedroom with original fireplace, a spacious family bathroom with walk in shower, twin sinks, toilet and Biday. There is also a further separate WC.

The original staircase with its iron and wood clad finish takes you to the top floor, a simple hall opens on to two bedrooms, one featuring triple aspect windows which could easily be divided to create another bedroom, the second offers an ensuite...
