With exposed beams and original stone walls, this lovely cottage could be a perfect first home or holiday home. The main living area on the ground floor is flooded with light in the afternoon. The enclosed garden is situated at the front of the house and gives privacy thanks to mature hedges and trees (including fruit trees, and a herb border). At the back is a small graveled yard which could be another seating area.

Parking is currently at the side of the property, accessed via the entrance to an adjacent field. A future owner may wish to create a new entry from the road at the bottom of the garden.

An added bonus is that the fosse septique septic complies with current standards.

The beautiful and popular Lac de Guerlèdan is just fifteen minutes drive away and offers such attractions as the lakeside beaches, bars, restaurants, walking and hiking, horse riding and of course water-sports such as canoeing, water-skiing, sailing and swimming.
