

Well-placed bar-restaurant in historical Dordogne village



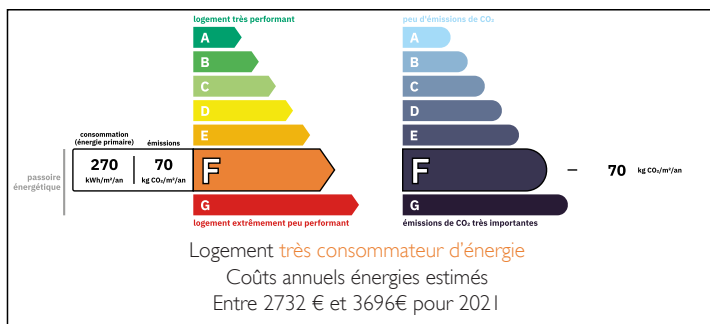
