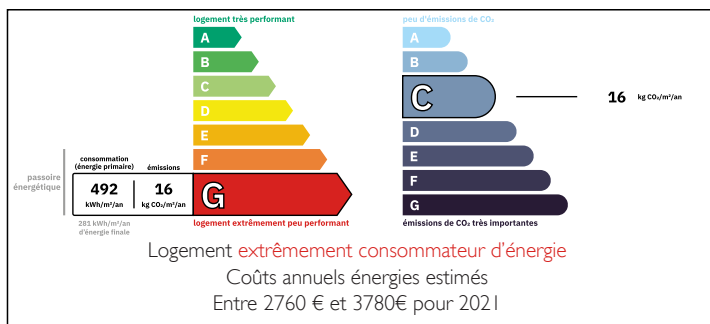

DESCRIPTION

Charming Stone House with Garden, Conservatories & Woodland

Set behind wooden gates, this welcoming stone house offers a peaceful retreat in a quiet hamlet. The gates open to a private parking area and a front garden with mature shrubs, trees, and a sunny sitting area — perfect for enjoying the tranquil surroundings.

Inside, the spacious lounge features a woodburner, creating a cosy heart to the home. Off the lounge is a versatile room currently used as an office and dining area. To the rear, a bright conservatory serves as a laundry/summer room with direct access to the rear garden. From here, a small hallway leads to a shower room with WC, sink, and shower.

The kitchen includes a tiled floor, fitted cupboards, and space for a dining table. It also opens into a second, front-facing conservatory.

Upstairs, there are two bedrooms and a bathroom, along with a storage room and additional storage space in the attic. The house is double glazed and the bedrooms have electric panel heaters.

Outside, the rear garden features a shed, open garage, and wood store. Directly across the quiet road is a private plot of woodland — a rare and peaceful addition to this characterful property.
