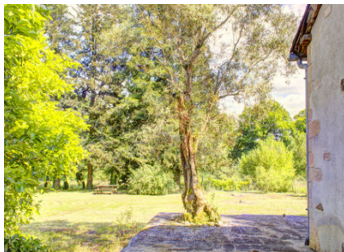

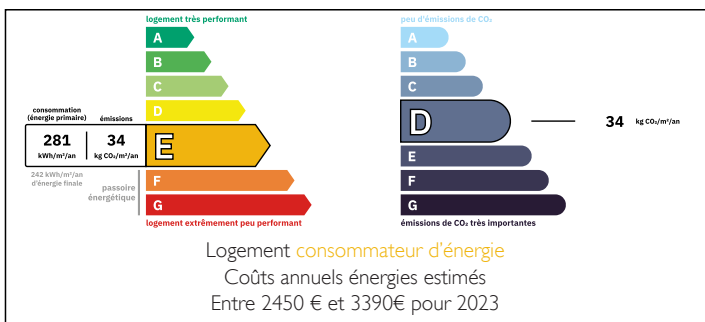
IN BRIEF

The property comprises a traditional-style farmhouse, a two-storey barn, a paved courtyard and a splendid south-facing garden planted with huge mature trees that provide welcome shade during the summer months. The garden also has a terrace with a barbecue area and lovely views of the beautiful Béarnaise countryside.

DESCRIPTION

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Built in the late 1800s, this cosy Béarnaise farmhouse has been stylishly renovated to combine a contemporary décor with traditional architectural features, which include exposed beams, exposed stone walls, a traditional wooden staircase and a Béarnaise stone sink.

This welcoming family home (118m²) also has a large two-storey barn (60m² x 2) on the far side of the paved courtyard and a lovely garden with a terrace for dining alfresco. The south-facing garden (1,115m²) has delightful views of the surrounding countryside - and there is plenty of flat land for a swimming pool, if desired.

From the courtyard, the front door of the house opens into a small hall area with a wooden staircase to the upper floors. To the left is a spacious, open-plan sitting room/dining room, which has a traditional Béarnaise stone sink and a fireplace with a Jotul wood-burning insert. Beyond this room is a spacious kitchen with French doors out to the garden.

To the right of the hall area are two adjoining rooms, a shower room and a separate WC. The rooms could be transformed into a ground-floor master-bedroom suite, a B&B suite for accommodating holidaymakers/pilgrims or used as office space/consulting rooms.

The first floor of the farmhouse comprises a bedroom with built-in wardrobes, a master bedroom, also with built-in wardrobes, and an adjoining family bathroom. The second floor, which has sloping ceilings, is currently used as a huge loft-style bedroom, but could easily be divided up to make two separate bedrooms or...
