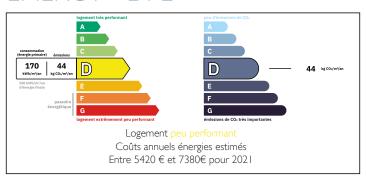

Bathed in sunlight thanks to its south-facing orientation, the main house boasts expansive living areas filled with natural light throughout the day.

Step into the welcoming entrance hall (25m²), which leads to a refined salon (33m²) on one side and a spacious dining room (34m²) on the other—ideal for entertaining. The fully equipped kitchen (13m²) is complemented by a handy food storage area (5m²), and there's also a ground-floor shower room with WC for added convenience.

At the front of the property, a bright conservatory/veranda (13m²) provides a serene space to relax and enjoy views of the garden.

Upstairs, you'll find four generous double bedrooms: 11m<sup>2</sup>, 11.5m<sup>2</sup>, 20m<sup>2</sup>, 36m<sup>2</sup>

There are two luxurious, modern en-suite bathrooms (7m<sup>2</sup> & 12m<sup>2</sup>), both featuring contemporary Italian walk-in showers and sleek finishes.

To the side of the house is a beautifully finished independent one-bedroom gîte — ideal for guests, holiday rentals, or multi-generational living. It includes a bright open-plan living/dining/kitchen area (25.8m²), a large double bedroom with a stylish shower room, and a separate WC (25m² total).

At the rear of the property is a truly spectacular
