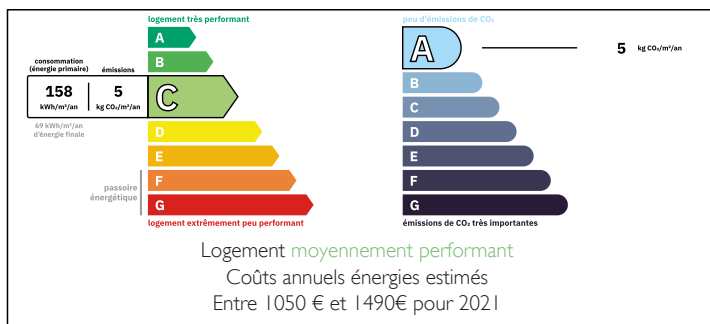

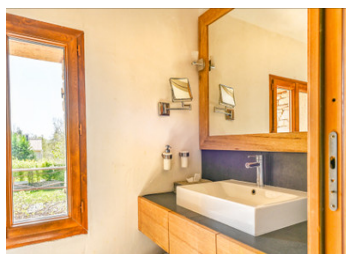
Upstairs, there are two beautiful suites, each with its own shower room and WC.
