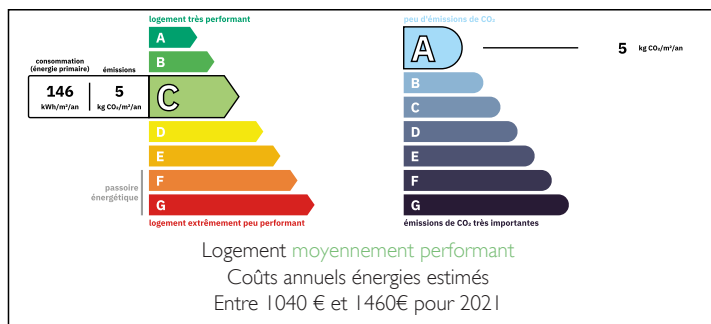


ROUSSILLON, PROVENCE – Elegant 5 Beds Country Retreat with Pool, Terraces and Sweeping Luberon Views

The main house, all on one level, features a fully equipped kitchen open to a bright living area, 4 bedrooms including 2 en-suite, and a separate guest annex with a 5th bedroom and bathroom.
