A place with a soul (antique parquet floors, exposed stonework and beams, fireplaces) and an abundance of space: pétanque court, vegetable garden, carports and garages.

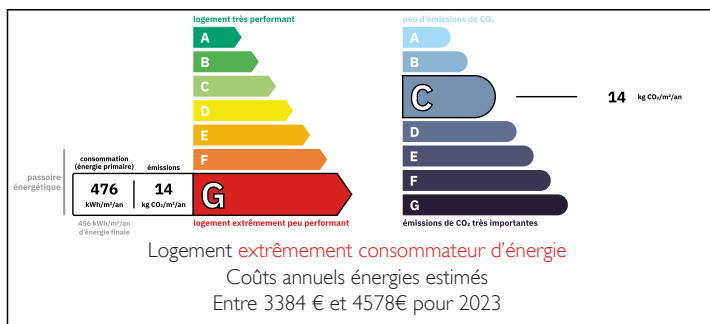
