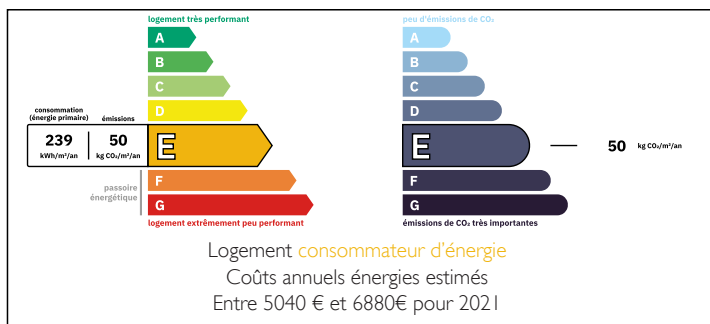

Multiple outbuildings with existing planning permissions to substantially increase the habitable space. Includes a manor house, several houses, barns, wine cellar, and sheepfold. Natural spring, well, large water reservoir, permaculture vegetable garden, and truffle orchard. A new 2024 phyto-purification system supports 75 residents and up to 300 for events. DESCRIPTION

Set in a peaceful and picturesque natural environment in the heart of the Périgord Vert, this exceptional hamlet is now offered for sale. The property includes approximately 420 m² of habitable space, a variety of outbuildings, and 34.6 hectares (85 acres) of continuous land made up of orchards, farmland, and forest.

This unique estate presents an ideal opportunity for a large family home, an ecological living project, or a combined agricultural and tourism venture. With existing planning permissions in place, the total potential for built space extends to 2,150 m², of which up to 1,940 m² could be used as living accommodation.

The current buildings include a beautiful 215.35 m² maison de maître with an adjoining 107 m² garage. Planning permission has already been granted to convert this space into a multipurpose reception hall for up to 99 guests and a gîte accommodating 14 people. There is also a 88.23 m² house, which can be extended by a further 50 m², and includes two solid outbuildings used for storage. A 117,31 m² former farmhouse is also part of the ensemble, with permission to convert and extend it to 308 m². This sits alongside a 169 m² barn, which has approval for transformation into a residence with a possible extension up to 335 m².

Also on the property is a charming 62 m² former dwelling, with plans allowing its expansion to 114 m². A large barn and workshop area totaling 173 m² already has permission to be converted...

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
