

The master suite features a dressing room, bathroom, separate toilet, and laundry room. The bedroom opens onto a private terrace, perfect for relaxing moments.

An independent guest house offers a bedroom, bathroom with toilet, and its own private terrace. Finally, two artist studios or home offices, each with separate entrances, complete this unique property—ideal for creatives or remote work.

Set on nearly 17,000 m² of impeccably landscaped grounds, the estate features century-old olive trees, a majestic linden tree, and typical Provençal plants such as lavender. At the heart of the garden, a large gated swimming pool (12.5 m × 5 m) invites relaxation, while ample parking makes daily life easy. A shaded pétanque court completes this idyllic setting, offering a friendly and refreshing space for games with friends or family.
