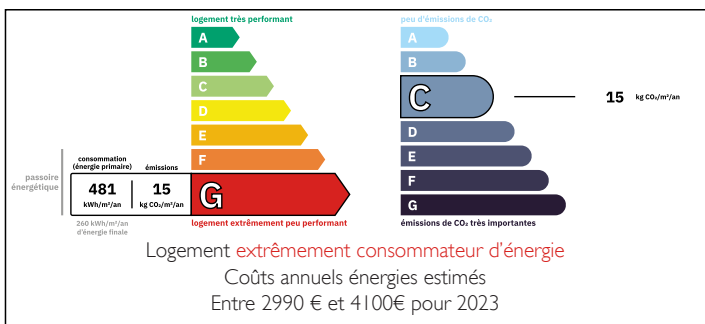

DESCRIPTION

Approached via a short narrow lane, you arrive in the courtyard in front of the property.

Step inside via the entrance hall, where you'll find a ground-floor bathroom. To one side, a delightful dual-aspect sitting room, 24m², welcomes you with exposed stone walls, timber beams, a feature fireplace with a wood-burning stove, and an original tiled floor. A door opens onto the rear garden, offering lovely views and privacy. Just off the sitting room is an additional room, 9m², — ideal as a home office or a third bedroom if required.

A staircase leads up to the first double bedroom, 16m², featuring an exposed stone wall, a small dressing area with fitted cupboards, and a bathroom with basin and WC.

To the other side of the entrance hall is the kitchen, 24m², again dual aspect, with a beautiful original fireplace, fitted units, tiled flooring, and a bespoke spiral staircase leading up to the second bedroom, 20m².

Outside, a small storeroom is attached to the main house, and across the courtyard, you'll find a large character barn 56m², — perfect for storage, workshop use, or conversion potential (subject to permissions).

The mature garden is full of charm, with shrubs, lawned areas, and a small enclosed side garden offering a quiet retreat.
