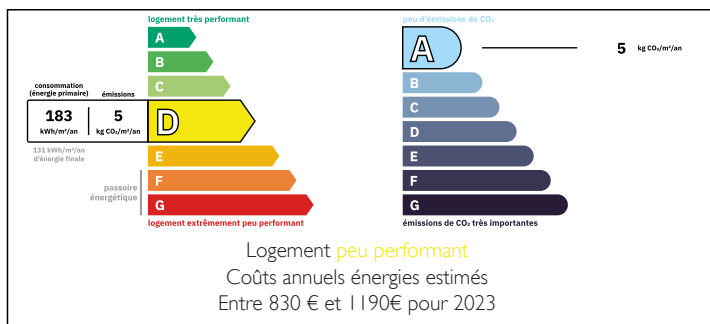

DESCRIPTION

Located in a quiet hamlet near Tilly (36) and Coulonges-les-Hérolles (86), this charming stone-built home offers immediate comfort, recent eco-upgrades, and future potential. Set on a plot of over 1,100m², the property includes an attached barn of approx. 90m² and a detached outbuilding of around 50m², ideal for storage, workshop use, or future conversion (subject to permissions).

Inside, the ground floor features an entrance hall, two comfortable bedrooms, a bright living room, a separate kitchen, and a full bathroom with WC. A corridor links the main rooms and leads to the staircase accessing the convertible attic above, currently divided into two separate spaces by a stone wall.

This home benefits from a heat pump for central heating, a wood pellet burner, PVC double-glazed windows, roof insulation, and a solar water heater, making it efficient and comfortable year-round. The property is on a septic tank.

Outside, the attached garden and terrace offer space for outdoor dining and relaxing, while across the quiet hamlet road lies additional land. The setting is peaceful and rural yet within easy reach of shops and amenities in nearby villages.

Whether you're looking for a cosy main residence, a countryside retreat, or a project with room to grow, this property offers a rare mix of comfort, character, and potential in the heart of rural France.
