

DESCRIPTION

There is plenty of parking close by, and the house is on a corner plot on the edge of the village. The double-glazed timber double doors lead into a spacious entrance hall. To one side is a charming traditional glazed door, leading to the ground floor storage areas, the shower room with basin, which at present serves as a utility room, and the separate modern WC. A large window, and two smaller windows give onto the street.

Creamy terrazzo stairs, with an exposed stone wall, lead up to the first floor, which is an open area containing living, dining and kitchen spaces. There are two large windows to the front of the house (facing west) and large three-door glazed French windows giving onto the terrace, to the east. The living area is 31.2m² and the terrace 16.4m². Privacy to the terrace is ensured in summer by two lime trees.

On the top floor, again light and bright, with windows to the east and west, is at present one large bedroom and a smart new shower room. The east window gives a view of the church tower, and the west view is of an attractive newly renovated natural stone house across the street. It would be a simple job to create two bedrooms here if this were required, with the addition of two partitions and a door.

Character is added by three lovely exposed timber roof beams. The heating is all electric, but there is provision for a...
