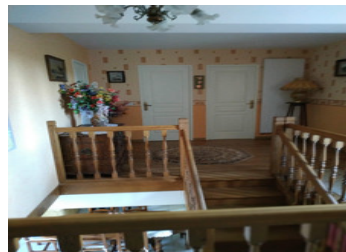


Renovated Stone House with Outbuildings Near Mautes, Creuse

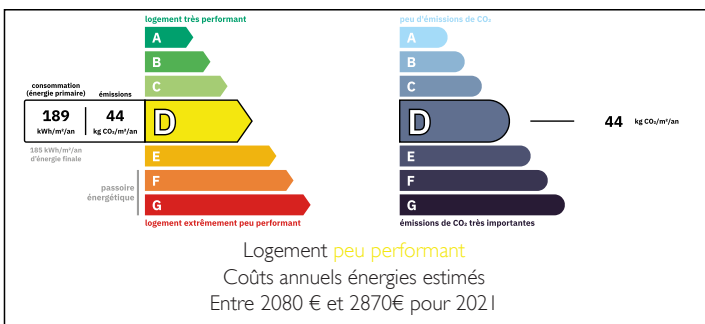

IN BRIEF

Charming renovated stone house dating from 1818, offering around 170 m² of living space over three levels. The property includes 3 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, a spacious living room, an office, and a home cinema area. Beautiful original features such as oak and ash staircases add to its character. Outbuildings include a double garage with boiler room, large 3-door barn (258 m²), wood store, and former cattle shed. Set on 1900 m² of land, the house is located near Mautes in the Creuse countryside, just minutes from local amenities, shops, and services. Peaceful rural setting with excellent access.

DESCRIPTION

Located just a short drive from the village of Mautes in the beautiful Creuse countryside, this charming stone house, built in 1818 and fully renovated in 2015, offers generous living space and excellent potential.

The ground floor features a welcoming entrance hall, a fitted kitchen, a dining room, an office, and a beautiful oak staircase. On the first floor, you'll find three bedrooms (22.76 m², 13.90 m², 12.36 m²), one main bathroom, and a second bathroom shared with Bedroom 1. A graceful ash staircase leads to the second floor, which offers a walk-in wardrobe, a spacious lounge area, and a dedicated home cinema/music room – ideal for relaxation or entertaining.

The property is complemented by several outbuildings: a double garage with oil-fired boiler room, a 3-door barn (258 m²), a wood store, and a former cattle shed, perfect for storage, workshops, or conversion.

Set on a 1900 m² plot, the house enjoys a peaceful rural environment with panoramic countryside views. Local essentials are available in Mautes, with amenities in nearby villages. For a full range of supermarkets, retail, healthcare, and cultural amenities, the historic town of Aubusson is just 20 minutes away by car. Ideal for those seeking tranquility without sacrificing accessibility.

A rare opportunity to acquire a beautifully maintained and character-filled home in a quiet but accessible location in the heart of Nouvelle-Aquitaine.
