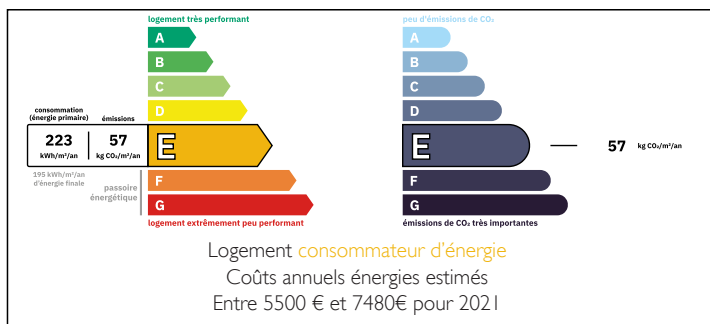

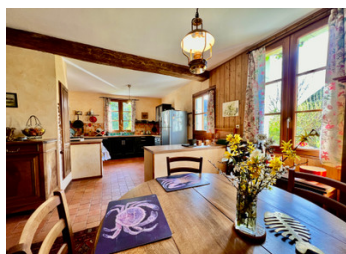

DESCRIPTION

The house comprises :

On the ground floor - Entrance from the delightful terrace and wisteria covered pergola; fully fitted kitchen and dining room; boiler and utility room; a lean-to storage space; passageway leading to a large split-level living room with fireplace. From this light-filled room you will enjoy views over the garden to the front and the back. A corridor leads to three bedrooms, a bathroom and access to the cellar; a study with fireplace.

On the first floor - A landing leading to a large bedroom under the eaves; shower room; large room ready to convert into a further bedroom or a living space.

Outside: Land totalling 5016m², laws, mature flower beds and shrubs; a delightful heated swimming pool. A handsome 80m² suitable to use as a large garage or extensive workshop. A collection of stone outbuildings and a lean-to shed.

The property is nicely enclosed and not over-looked. The location is rural whilst being a very short distance from the pretty village so St Martin de La Place and its boulangerie, restaurants, primary school. Saumur is just 12km from the property, with intercity train station and major amenities.
