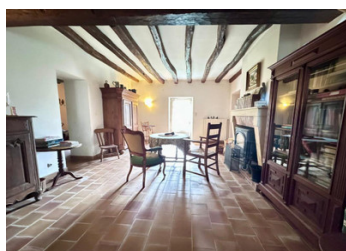


Charming Country House with Barn, Workshop & Renovation Potential on 5901 m

DESCRIPTION

This charming country home is set on a peaceful 5901 m² plot in a quiet hamlet near Bussy, in the Cher department (Centre-Val de Loire region), offering approx. 145 m² of habitable space. The layout includes:

Ground floor:

- A spacious open-plan kitchen and dining area (43.6 m²)

First floor:

- A large converted attic room (approx. 48 m²), ideal as a third bedroom or additional living space
- The attached barn and workshop provide plenty of room for storage, hobbies, or further conversion. The ruined stone house adds even more value and flexibility, offering a project for those looking to expand or create guest accommodation (subject to planning).

The house benefits from gas central heating and a roof in good condition. Structurally sound, the interior would benefit from some refreshment to bring out its full potential.
