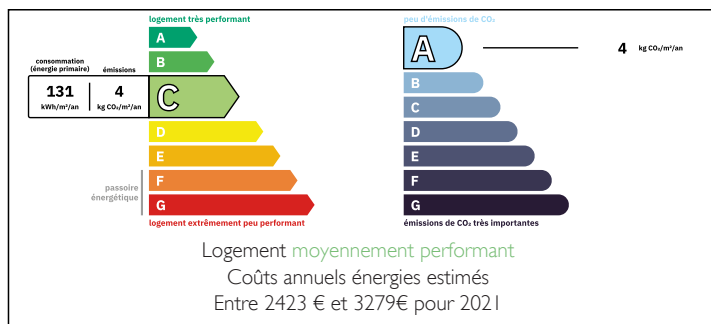

As soon as you enter, you will be charmed by the many period features: oak parquet flooring, exposed beams, stone fireplaces, perfectly preserved old tiles and even a unique floor known as 'en cœur de demoiselle' in the kitchen. The convertible dovecote, connecting the outbuildings in a wing, recalls the history of the property, which was once dedicated to cognac production, with an original wine press and barrel still remaining.

The residence offers spacious living areas:

- 7 bedrooms, including a 40 m² master suite,
- 2 bathrooms, 2 shower rooms
- an authentic kitchen,
- a spacious dining room,
- a bright living room opening directly onto the garden.

The 5,800 m² enclosed grounds feature a 12 m swimming pool and multiple relaxation areas, as well as a barn that can accommodate 3 to 5 cars.

This exceptional property combines elegance, prestige and the gentle way of life in Charente. Angoulême, a lively and cultural city, famous for its International Comics Festival, its Francophone Film Festival, its Gastronomades and numerous other events, is located in the immediate vicinity.
